Online Registration

For the online registration, please visit the following website:

First you need to create an account, verify the account via your e-mail and fill in the online application form. Please save your username and password for future reference. After that procedure you can login back and fill in your application form.

You will also need to upload your signed Learning Agreement and a photo, otherwise the system will not let you submit the application. Please make sure to fill in all the fields required.

When filling in your application be careful of the dates you're selecting for your studies as well as the date of your birth because these dates will be displayed on your Erasmus ID card and cannot be changed later. You will also need to take under consideration that our office is open for students every day Monday to Thursday (except Fridays), therefore your arrival and departure should coincide with these dates.

erasmus-incoming@auth.gr along with the signed Learning Agreement.
