

Very important information for foreign applicants

In order to study Applied Theatre Studies, you have to have passed the entrance examination (see our homepage) and have successfully completed the admission to the Justus-Liebig University via uni-assist.

Applicants to the German-speaking BA and MA Applied Theatre Studies degrees at the JLU Giessen must have proof that they can speak German. That is also applicable for all applicants without a German Abitur qualification.

You can not be admitted to the degree course at the JLU solely upon successfully completing the entrance examination. You also have to fulfill the language requirements.

The decision to admit an applicant to a university course in Germany is not made at the Institute for Applied Theatre Studies but at the Justus-Liebig University's central admission office. The applicants are responsible for providing the necessary verification documents additionally to passing the examination.

What happens if you do not meet the language requirements?

All foreign applicants without a German Abitur qualification must apply via the uni-assist system. This process consists of uni-assist assessing whether your application documents are complete and eligible to authorise you to study at the JLU resulting in the desired qualification. (This process is charged to you at a fee). **This inspection is independent of the entrance examination at the Institute for Applied Theatre Studies.**
